NOTICE OF RACE

GENERAL INFORMATION

1. RULES

- 1.1 This regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the *Racing Rules of Sailing*.
- 1.2 Rules 63.1, A4.1 and A5 will be changed to provide that a boat starting more than five (5) minutes after her starting signal will be scored DNS without a hearing.
- 1.3 Rule 63.7 will be replaced with: "If there is any conflict between a rule in the Notice of Race and one in the Sailing Instructions, the Sailing Instructions shall apply."
- 1.4 Rule 82 will not apply. Competitors must submit the standard [CYC Entry Form](#), available at [on-line registration](#) or CYC.
- 1.5 Appendix T, Section A, Penalties While Racing, rule T1 will apply.
- 1.6 Appendix T, Section C, Expedited Hearings, rules T3 and T4 will apply, except rule T4.6.

2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1 This series is open to the following one-design keelboat classes: J/24, J/70, J/80, J/109, Martin 242, Star, Tartan 101, and Viper 640. One-design classes with the same PHRF Area B rating may be combined into one class. Other one-design classes may apply with a minimum of three (3) paid entries.
- 2.2 To be eligible for entry, a boat must be entered by an individual who is a member of US Sailing or an organization affiliated to US Sailing or their own national authority. Information about joining US Sailing is available at www.ussailing.org.
- 2.3 Each entrant shall complete the online entry process at the [Summer One Design](#) webpage or submit a [CYC Entry Form](#) at the CYC front desk, and pay the entry fee prior to 1800 on Saturday, July 11 for the July 12 races and prior to 1800 on Saturday, August 15 for the August 16 races.
- 2.4 Late entries may be accepted with the prior approval of the Regatta Chair.

3. CLASSES

- 3.1 Classes will be established for one-design boats that have a minimum of three (3) paid entries prior to 1800 on Saturday, July 11 for the July 12 races and prior to 1800 on Saturday, August 15 for the August 16 races.
- 3.2 Class flags and order of starts will be posted on the bulletin board outside the main entrance to CYC (Official Notice Board) and online at the [Summer One Design](#) webpage by 1900, Saturday, July 11 for the July 12 races and by 1900, Saturday, August 15 for the August 16 races.

4. FEES

The entry fee for an individual race day is \$25 for US Sailing members, and \$30 for non-members. The entry fee for the series is \$40 for US Sailing members, and \$50 for non-members.

5. SCHEDULE

- 5.1 Sunday, July 12, and Sunday, August 16: the Warning Signal for the first class will be at 1225.
- 5.2 Three (3) races are scheduled on each race day. The Race Committee (RC), at its discretion, may run fewer total races.
- 5.3 Trophy presentation will be at CYC after racing each day.

6. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The Sailing Instructions will be posted at the [Summer One Design](#) webpage by 2100, Monday, July 6 and will be available at the CYC Front Desk on request.

7. VENUE

The racing area will be in Santa Monica Bay, offshore from the Venice Pier.

8. THE COURSES

Windward / leeward courses, finishing downwind, will be utilized.

9. SCORING

9.1 All race scores will count.

9.2 One (1) race must be completed to constitute a series.

10. RADIO COMMUNICATION

While on the water, the RC may communicate with competing boats via VHF radio or loudhailer, including starting penalties.

11. PRIZES

Prizes will be awarded after racing each day based on the number of entries in each class. On August 16, overall class series trophies will be presented.

12. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in this regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. By participating in this regatta, each competitor agrees to release the race organizers (organizing authority, host yacht club, race committee, protest committee, sponsors, and any others acting in an official capacity for this event) from any and all liability associated with such competitor's participation in this regatta to the fullest extent permitted by law.
