1. RULES

- 1.1 This regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the *Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS)*.
- 1.2 RRS 82 will not apply. Competitors must complete the Race Entry Agreement through online registration at the King of Spain webpage or submit a CYC Race Entry form.
- 1.3 Appendix V, Section V1, Penalty at the Time of an Incident, will apply.

2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1 This regatta is open to Star class boats.
- 2.2 Each boat must be entered by an individual who is a member of (1) US Sailing or an organization affiliated to US Sailing, their own National Authority or to SCYA and (2) the International Star Class Yacht Racing Association (ISCYRA).
- 2.3 Each entrant shall complete the [online registration](#) or submit a [CYC Race Entry](#) form, and pay all fees prior to 1800 on Friday, July 21.
- 2.4 Late entries may be accepted with the prior approval of the Regatta Chair.

3. FEES

The entry fee is \$50 for US Sailing members, \$60 for non-members. Information about joining US Sailing is available at www.ussailing.org or at 800.877.2451.

4. SCHEDULE

Seven (7) races are scheduled: four (4) on Saturday and three (3) on Sunday. The Race Committee, at its discretion, may run fewer races.

5. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The Sailing Instructions will be posted at the [King of Spain](#) webpage by Tuesday, July 18 and will be available at the CYC front desk on request.

6. VENUE

The racing area will be on Santa Monica Bay approximately one (1) nautical mile northwest of the Marina del Rey breakwater.

7. THE COURSES

Courses will be primarily windward/leeward.

8. SCORING

- 8.1 When fewer than five races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of all her race scores. When five or more races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.
- 8.2 One (1) race must be completed to constitute a regatta.

9. SUPPORT BOATS

Competitors who wish to keep support boats at CYC must make prior arrangements with the CYC Dockmaster for use of the hoist, trailer storage and in-the-water berthing. Contact CYC Dockmaster Evan Davis at evan.davis@calyachtclub.net or at 310.823.4567.

10. PRIZES

- 10.1 Trophies will be awarded after racing on Sunday based on the number of entries received.
- 10.2 The names of the winning skipper and crew will be inscribed on the King of Spain Trophy, which will remain on display at CYC.
