NOTICE OF RACE

GENERAL INFORMATION

1. RULES

- 1.1 This series will be governed by the *rules* as defined in the *Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS)*, the [Shadden Series Standing Rule](#), and the [2016-2017 Shadden Series Notice of Race](#).
- 1.2 Sail number and crew changes must be approved by the Shadden Series Chairman, Mike Segerblom (mikesego@ussclub.org) and reported to the Race Committee (RC) before the first race.
- 1.3 In addition to the requirements of RRS 40 and its US Sailing Prescription, a condition of entry and participation in this regatta is the wearing of a US Coast Guard approved PFD, or a PFD approved by the country of their citizenship or residence, properly secured at all times while on the water, except for brief periods while removing or adding clothing. Wet suits, dry suits and inflatable PFDs do not constitute adequate personal buoyancy. All PFDs must be suitable for the competitor's weight. Violation of this provision will result in a penalty up to and including disqualification at the discretion of the Protest Committee, which changes RRS 64.1.
- 1.4 RRS 63.1, A4.1 and A5 will be changed so that a boat starting more than five (5) minutes after her Starting Signal will be scored DNS without a hearing.
- 1.5 RRS 82 will not apply. Competitors must submit the standard CYC Entry Form, available through the on-line entry process or at CYC.

2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1 This regatta is open to CFJ Class boats that have a valid measurement certificate on file with the CFJ Class Secretary.
- 2.2 Each participant shall be under the age of nineteen (19) and have not yet entered college. Participants should be members of an SCYA or SCYYRA organization.
- 2.3 Either the skipper or crew of each boat shall be a member in good standing of the CFJ Class Association
- 2.4 Each skipper shall complete the online entry process at [Regatta Toolbox](#) and pay all fees prior to 1200 Saturday, October 7, 2017. For skippers under the age of eighteen (18), this shall be done by their parent or guardian. Registration after that time may be accepted only with prior approval of the Regatta Chair.
- 2.5 In addition, the parents of each skipper and crew under the age of eighteen (18) shall submit a [CYC Parental Consent Form](#) no later than 1200 Saturday, October 7, 2017. This shall be mailed or delivered to:

- 2.6 Only boats that have completed check-in by 0930 Sunday, October 8, 2017 will be eligible to race. Late check-in may be allowed only with prior approval of the Regatta Chair.

3. CHECK-IN

- 3.1 All competitors must check-in between 0830 and 0930 on Sunday, October 8, 2017, at CYC on the Pool Patio.
- 3.2 Check-in includes completing the online registration process and paying all fees, plus submission of a completed [CYC Parental Consent Form](#), signed by a parent or guardian, if needed (see **NOR 2.5**).
- 3.3 Each boat will be issued a supplemental sail number at Check-in, which shall be affixed to the starboard side of the main sail above the top-most batten and no more than six (6) inches from the luff.

4. FEES

The entry fee is \$35 for boats that register before 1800 Wednesday October 4. Thereafter, until the registration deadline of 1200 October 7, the entry fee is \$45. The entry fee includes complimentary refreshments at the trophy presentation.

Five (5) races are scheduled. The RC, at its discretion, may run fewer races.

6. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The Sailing Instructions will be posted at [Shadden Series](#) website by Wednesday, October 4, 2017, and printed copies will be available only upon request.

7. VENUE

The racing area will be on Santa Monica Bay approximately one (1) nautical mile northwest of the Marina del Rey breakwater.

8. THE COURSES

Courses will be primarily windward/leeward with some reaching legs if conditions warrant.

9. SCORING

- 9.1 All race scores will count.
- 9.2 One (1) race must be completed to constitute a regatta.

10. SAFETY AND ADULT RESPONSIBILITY

- 10.1 Each skipper that launches their boat from CYC must sign-out prior to leaving the dock and sign-in upon return. Each skipper not launching from CYC shall notify Regatta Committee at Check-In. Following the final race, each skipper not launching from CYC shall notify a Regatta co-Chair, Christopher Gale at (978) 618-9394 or Hunter Gorog at (310) 499-8601 as soon as practical to confirm that they have returned to their dock.
- 10.2 Each competitor under eighteen (18) shall submit a [CYC Parental Consent Form](#), signed by their parent or guardian, which indicates the parent or adult representative ("designated adult") that will be responsible for the competitor throughout the event. (See **NOR 2.5**)
- 10.3 It is solely the responsibility of the designated adult to decide if the competitor should sail in the weather and sea conditions that might arise during the event. Additionally, the designated adult shall accept full responsibility for all actions of the competitor during any activity related to the event. This includes on-shore activities before, during, and after the regatta.
- 10.4 Competitors over the age of eighteen (18) are responsible for their own actions, and for the decision to sail in weather and sea conditions that might arise during the event.

11. COACH / SUPPORT BOATS

- 11.1 Only coach/support boats that have registered with the Race Committee (RC) and prominently display identification provided by the RC will be allowed in the racing area. There will be a refundable deposit of \$20 required for each identification flag.
- 11.2 All coach/support boats must carry and monitor a VHF radio and check-in with the RC at the starting area via VHF radio. All individuals on such registered boats are required to wear PFDs.
- 11.3 The Sailing Instructions will govern the conduct of registered coach/support boats and all other boats, including spectator boats.
- 11.4 Competitors who wish to keep coach/support boats at CYC must make arrangements with the Dockmaster for use of the hoist, trailer storage and in-the-water berthing. Contact CYC Dockmaster Evan Davis at evan.davis@calyachtclub.net or at 310.823.4567.

12. PRIZES

Prizes will be awarded after racing on Sunday.
