# 1. RULES

- 1.1 This regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the *Racing Rules of Sailing* (RRS) and the <u>Pacific 52 Class Association (Pac52) Rules</u>.
- 1.2 RRS 82 will not apply.
- 1.3 If there is a conflict between this Notice of Race (NoR) and/or the Sailing Instructions (SI) and the Pac52 Rules, the Pac52 Rules shall prevail.
- 1.4 Additional rule changes regarding penalties and scoring will be in the SI, in accordance with the Pac52 Rules.

# 2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1 Entry in this regatta is by invitation only and is restricted to boats that meet the eligibility requirements of the Pac52 Class Association.
- 2.2 Eligible boats may enter by completing online registration at the <u>California Cup Regatta</u> webpage and paying all fees prior to 1800 on Sunday, May 27. Entries submitted after that time may be accepted with the approval of the Regatta Chair.

#### 3. FEES

The entry fee is \$450.

# 4. SCHEDULE

8 races are scheduled: 3 on Friday, 3 on Saturday and 2 on Sunday. The Race Committee (RC), at its discretion, may run fewer races.

# 5. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The Sailing Instructions will be posted at the <u>California Cup Regatta</u> webpage by Sunday, May 27 and will be available at the CYC Front Desk by 1200 on Thursday, May 31.

#### 6. VENUE

The racing area will be on Santa Monica Bay west of the Marina del Rey breakwater.

# 7. THE COURSES

Courses will be a windward / leeward format.

#### 8. SCORING

- 8.1 A boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.
- 8.2 One (1) race must be completed to constitute a regatta.

# 9. RADIO COMMUNICATION

While on the water, the RC may communicate with competing boats via VHF radio, including starting penalties.

# 10. PRIZES

- 10.1 Take home trophies will be awarded based on the number of entries received.
- 10.2 The names of the winning boat and owner will be inscribed on the California Cup Perpetual Trophy, which shall remain on display at CYC. In addition, a half-hull model of the winning boat will be displayed at CYC.

# 11. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors in this event are participating entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. By participating in this event, each competitor agrees to release the race organizers (organizing authority, host yacht club, race committee, protest committee, sponsors, and any others acting in an official capacity for this event) from any and all liability associated with such competitor's participation in this event to the fullest extent permitted by law.
