NOTICE OF RACE

GENERAL INFORMATION

The notation '[DP]' in a rule in the NoR means that the penalty for a breach of that rule may, at the discretion of the protest committee, be less than disqualification.

1. RULES

- 1.1 This series will be governed by the rules as defined in the *Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS)*, by the <u>Club FJ Class Association</u> <u>Rules</u>, by the <u>Shadden Standing Rule</u>, and by the 2018-2019 Shadden Perpetual Trophy Series Notice of Race.
- 1.2 RRS 82 will not apply.
- 1.3 A condition of entry and participation in this regatta is the wearing of a U.S. Coast Guard approved lifejacket or, for international sailors only, a lifejacket approved by their country's corresponding authority, properly secured at all times while on the water, except for brief periods while removing or adding clothing. All lifejackets must be suitable for the competitor's weight. Wet suits, dry suits, and inflatable lifejackets do not constitute adequate personal buoyancy. These changes are added to rule 40, and the Preamble to Part 4 will not apply to rule 40. [DP]

2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1 Eligible skippers may enter their boat by completing online registration at the <u>Shadden #2</u> webpage and paying all fees prior to 1800 on Saturday, October 6. For skippers under the age of eighteen (18), this shall be done by their parent or guardian. Entries submitted after that time may be accepted only with the approval of a Regatta Chair and will be charged a \$10 late fee.
- 2.2 Only entries that have completed Check-in by 0900 on Sunday, October 7 will be eligible to race. Late Check-in may be allowed only with the approval of a Regatta Chair.

3. CHECK-IN

- 3.1 Check-in will be on the CYC pool patio from 0800-0900 on Sunday, October 7.
- 3.2 Check-in includes completing online registration and paying all fees.
- 3.3 Each boat will be issued a supplemental sail number at Check-in, which shall be affixed according to the Sailing Instructions [DP].

4. FEES

The entry fee is \$35 for entries received by Wednesday, October 3. Thereafter, until the entry deadline, the entry fee is \$45.

Five (5) races are scheduled. The RC, at its discretion, may run fewer races.

6. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The Sailing Instructions will be posted at the <u>Shadden #2</u> webpage by Wednesday, October 3, and printed copies will be available at Check-in only upon request. Course Charts will be available at Check-in.

7. VENUE

The racing area will be on Santa Monica Bay approximately one (1) nautical mile northwest of the Marina del Rey breakwater.

8. THE COURSES

Courses will be primarily windward/leeward with some reaching legs if conditions warrant.

9. SCORING

- 9.1 All race scores will count.
- 9.2 One (1) race must be completed to constitute a regatta.

10. SAFETY

Each skipper who launches their boat from CYC must sign-out prior to leaving the dock and sign-in upon return. Each skipper not launching from CYC shall notify a Regatta Chair before leaving their dock and, following the final race of the day, shall notify a Regatta Chair as soon as practical to confirm they have returned to their dock. [DP] (See NoR 15 for Regatta Chair contact information.)

11. DESIGNATED ADULT

- 11.1 An adult (parent, guardian or designated adult) is responsible for the safety of each competitor under the age of eighteen (18). It is solely the responsibility of this adult to decide if the competitor should sail in the weather and sea conditions that might arise during the event. The adult supervising the competitor is ultimately responsible for the risks. Additionally, the designated adult shall accept full responsibility for all actions of the competitor during any activity related to the event. This includes on-shore activities before, during, and after the regatta.
- 11.2 Any parent or guardian not personally attending any part of the event shall provide, during online registration, the name and contact information for the adult who shall be on-site, and who is authorized and designated to be responsible for their child during this event per NoR 11.1.
- 11.3 Competitors who are eighteen (18) years or older are responsible for their own actions, and for the decision to sail in weather and sea conditions that might arise during the event.

12. COACH / SUPPORT BOATS

- 12.1 Coach/support boats must register with the RC and prominently display an identification flag provided by the RC. Only registered coach/support boats will be allowed in the racing area. There will be a refundable deposit of \$20 required for each identification flag, payable on-site on October 7 [DP].
- 12.2 All coach/support boats must carry and monitor a VHF radio. All individuals on such registered boats are required to wear PFDs. [DP]
- 12.3 The conduct of registered coach/support boats, all other support boats, and support persons, will be governed by the Sailing Instructions.
- 12.4 Coach/support and spectator boats shall not be launched or recovered at CYC while competitors are launching or recovering their dinghies. [DP]
- 12.5 Competitors who wish to keep coach/support boats at CYC must make arrangements with the Dockmaster for use of the hoist, trailer storage and in-the-water berthing. Contact CYC Dockmaster, Evan Davis at <u>evan.davis@calyachtclub.net</u> or at 310.823.4567

13. PRIZES

Prizes will be awarded after racing.

Competitors in this event are participating entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. By participating in this regatta, each competitor agrees to release the race organizers (organizing authority, host yacht club, race committee, protest committee, sponsors, and any others acting in an official capacity for this event) from any and all liability associated with such competitor's participation in this regatta to the fullest extent permitted by law.
