NOTICE OF RACE

GENERAL INFORMATION

1. RULES

- 1.1 This regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the *Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS)*.
- 1.2 PHRF of Southern California (PHRF SoCal) <u>Class Rules</u> will be in effect for handicap boats.
- 1.3 RRS 82 will not apply.

2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1 This regatta is open to one-design keelboats and to handicap boats that have a valid PHRF SoCal Regular or Temporary Rating Certificate. Handicap boats must compete in a BUOY rated configuration not to exceed 186.
- 2.2 Eligible boats may enter by completing online registration at the <u>Summer Regatta</u> webpage or submitting a <u>CYC Race</u> <u>Entry</u> at the CYC front desk, and paying all fees prior to 1800 on Friday, July 20. Entries submitted after that time may be accepted only with the approval of the Regatta Chair and will be charged a \$10 late fee. Star class only: please include the names of both skipper and crew.

3. CLASSES

- 3.1 One-design keelboats must have a minimum of three (3) paid entries prior to the entry deadline to establish a class. Those with the same PHRF SoCal Area B BUOY rating may be combined to establish a Level Rating class. Those that do not establish a class may compete in a handicap class, if they are in compliance with the handicap boat requirements per NoR 2.1.
- 3.2 Handicap classes will be established at the discretion of the OA based on entries received by the entry deadline.
- 3.3 A class with fewer than five (5) entries may have their start combined with another class of similar size, though classes may be scored separately.
- 3.4 Classes, class flags and order of starts for the first race will be posted on the bulletin board outside the main entrance to CYC (Official Notice Board) and online at the Summer Regatta webpage by 1900, Friday, July 20.

4. FEES

The entry fee is \$30 for members of US Sailing with proof of membership, \$35 for non-members.

5. SCHEDULE

Four (4) races are scheduled. The Race Committee (RC), at its discretion, may run fewer races.

6. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The Sailing Instructions will be posted at the <u>Summer Regatta</u> webpage by Wednesday, July 18 and will be available at the CYC Front Desk on request.

7. VENUE

The racing area will be on Santa Monica Bay, approximately one (1) nautical mile northwest of the Marina del Rey breakwater.

8. THE COURSES

Courses will be a windward / leeward format.

9. SCORING

- 9.1 A boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.
- 9.2 One (1) race must be completed to constitute a regatta.
- 9.3 Handicap boats will be scored with PHRF SoCal Regular or Temporary Area B BUOY Ratings. Non-spinnaker offsets will not be used. Boats from outside of Area B will have Area B adjustments applied as available.

10. RADIO COMMUNICATION

While on the water, the RC may communicate with competing boats via VHF radio, including starting penalties.

11. PRIZES

Trophies will be awarded after racing based on the number of entries in each class.

12. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in this event entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. By participating in this event, each competitor agrees to release the race organizers (organizing authority, host yacht club, race committee, protest committee, sponsors, and any others acting in an official capacity for this event) from any and all liability associated with such competitor's participation in this event to the fullest extent permitted by law.
