NOTICE OF RACE

GENERAL INFORMATION

The Organizing Authority (OA) is California Yacht Club (CYC), located at 4469 Admiralty Way, Marina del Rey, CA 90292

The notation '[DP]' in a rule in the NoR means that the penalty for a breach of that rule may, at the discretion of the protest committee, be less than disqualification.

1. RULES

- 1.1 This regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the *Racing Rules of Sailing* (RRS).
- 1.2 PHRF of Southern California (PHRF SoCal) Class Rules will be in effect for handicap classes.
- 1.3 RRS 82 will not apply.

2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1 This regatta is open to one-design keelboats, and to handicap boats that have a valid PHRF SoCal Regular or Temporary Rating Certificate. Handicap boats must compete in a BUOY rated configuration not to exceed 186.
- 2.2 Eligible boats may enter by completing online registration at <u>Cal Race Week Registration</u> and paying all fees by Wednesday, May 30. Entries submitted after that time may be accepted only with the approval of a Regatta Chair and will be charged a \$50 late fee.

3. CLASSES

- 3.1 One-design keelboats must have a minimum of three (3) paid entries prior to the entry deadline to establish a class. Invited one-design classes are Farr 40, J/109, J/105, J/80, J/70, J/24, Martin 242, Santana 30/30, Schock 35, Star, Tartan 101 and Viper 640, and any other one-design classes that meet the entry threshold. Those that do not establish a class may compete in a handicap class if they are in compliance with the handicap boat requirements per NoR 2.1.
- 3.2 Handicap classes will be established at the discretion of the OA based on entries received by the entry deadline.
- 3.3 A class with fewer than five (5) entries may have their start combined with another class of similar size, though classes may be scored separately.
- 3.4 Classes, class flags, race area assignments, and order of starts for the first race each day will be posted on the outside windows of the Gallery Room, downstairs in the CYC clubhouse (Official Notice Board) and online at the <u>Cal Race Week</u> webpage by 1230 on Friday, June 1.

4. FEES

The entry fee will be based on the LOA of the boat as set forth below. Boats whose LOA falls between categories (for example, 29.5 feet) should round down to the next foot to determine the entry fee.

5. SCHEDULE

For the J/70, Viper 640, Star, Martin 242, and J/24 classes, seven (7) races are scheduled: four (4) on Saturday and three (3) on Sunday. For other one-design and PHRF classes, five (5) races are scheduled: three (3) on Saturday and two (2) on Sunday. The RC, at its discretion, may run fewer races.

6. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The Sailing Instructions will be posted at the <u>Cal Race Week</u> webpage by Thursday, May 31 and will be available at registration.

7. VENUE

There will be multiple racing areas on Santa Monica Bay west of the Marina del Rey breakwater.

8. THE COURSES

Courses will be a windward / leeward format.

9. SCORING

- 9.1 A boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.
- 9.2 One (1) race must be completed to constitute a regatta.
- 9.3 Handicap boats will be scored with PHRF SoCal Regular or Temporary Area B BUOY ratings calculated using the Time on Time method, with a Time Correction Factor of 650 / (625 + PHRF) where PHRF is a boat's PHRF SoCal Regular or Temporary Area B BUOY rating. Boats from outside Area B will have Area B adjustments applied as available. Non-spinnaker offsets will not be used.

10. BERTHING / HAUL-OUT RESTRICTIONS

Boats in specified one-design classes will be assigned rafting areas at CYC, and shall remain in the water Saturday night. Boat trailers will be stored on CYC grounds in a specified area. [DP]

11. RADIO COMMUNICATION

While on the water, the RC may communicate with competing boats via VHF radio, including starting penalties.

12. PRIZES

- 12.1 Prizes will be awarded after racing on Sunday based on the number of entries in each class.
- 12.2 In addition, the following trophies will be presented:
 - The **Junior Crew Trophy** will be awarded to the best scoring boat in each class with at least one junior (<18) aboard. The form for entering the Junior Crew Trophy competition may be found at the <u>Cal Race Week</u> webpage.
 - The M242 Pacific Coast Championship Trophy, which shall remain on display at CYC, will be awarded to the first place Martin 242.
 - The **Jimmy Morris Trophy**, which shall remain on display at CYC, will be awarded to the first place Schock 35.
 - The Charles Tanner Trophy, which shall remain on display at CYC, will be awarded to the first place boat in each PHRF class.
 - The Fred F. Harris Trophy, which shall remain on display at CYC, will be awarded to the first place boat in each one-design class.
 - The **Thomas K. Armstrong California Challenge Trophy**, which shall remain on display at CYC, will be presented to the winning yacht club team. The Notice of Challenge may be found at the <u>Cal Race Week</u> webpage.

Competitors in this event are participating entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. By participating in this event, each competitor agrees to release the race organizers (organizing authority, host yacht club, race committee, protest committee, sponsors, and any others acting in an official capacity for this event) from any and all liability associated with such competitor's participation in this event to the fullest extent permitted by law.
