#### **GENERAL INFORMATION**

The Organizing Authority (OA) is California Yacht Club (CYC) and the International J/70 Class Association.

#### 1. RULES

- 1.1 This series will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing* (RRS).
- 1.2 <u>IJ70CA Class Rule</u> (CR) Part III, Section i.4 (Corinthian Division) will apply.
- 1.3 US Sailing Prescription RRS 82 will not apply.

#### 2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1 This series is open to all J/70 class boats.
- 2.2 Eligible boats may enter by completing online registration and paying the required fees at:
  - a) the <u>CYC 2019–2020 J/70 West Coast Winter Series</u> webpage for the regattas on December 7, January 18, and January 19; each day of racing must be entered separately;
  - b) the CYC SCYA Midwinter Regatta webpage for the regatta on February 8 & 9.
- 2.3 Entries must be received by 1900 on the day before each regatta. Entries submitted after that time will be accepted only with the approval of the Regatta Chair and will be charged a \$10 late fee.

#### 3. FEES

The entry fee is \$50 per day for December 7, January 18, and January 19. The entry fee for February 8 & 9 will be determined by SCYA.

Four (4) races are scheduled each day for December 7, January 18, and January 19. Five (5) races are scheduled for the SCYA Midwinter Regatta: three (3) on Saturday and two (2) on Sunday. The Race Committee (RC), at its discretion, may run fewer races.

Refreshments will follow at CYC after each race day.

Trophies will be awarded at CYC after racing on December 7, January 19, and February 9.

#### 5. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

- 5.1 For the regattas on December 7, January 18, and January 19, the Sailing Instructions will be posted at the <u>CYC 2019-2020 J/70 West Coast Winter Series webpage by Saturday, November 30, 2019.</u>
- 5.2 For the SCYA Midwinter Regatta on February 8 & 9, the Sailing Instructions will be posted at the <a href="CYC SCYA Midwinter">CYC SCYA Midwinter</a> Regatta webpage by Wednesday, February 5.

#### 6. VENUE

The racing area will be on Santa Monica Bay approximately one (1) nautical mile northwest of the Marina del Rey breakwater.

# 7. THE COURSES

Courses will be a windward/leeward format.

#### 8. SCORING

- 8.1 For each regatta:
  - a) One race must be completed to constitute a regatta.
  - b) All race scores will count.
- 8.2 For the J/70 West Coast Winter Series:
  - a) One (1) regatta must be completed to constitute a series.
  - b) A boat must compete in at least two regattas in the Series.
  - c) The racing on January 18 and January 19 will be considered a single regatta for scoring purposes.
  - d) A boat's Series score will be the total of her overall finishing places in her two best regattas in the Series.
  - e) If there is a tie between two or more boats, each boat's overall score in her two best regattas shall be listed in order of best to worst. At the first point(s) where there is a difference, the tie shall be broken in favour of the boat(s) with the best overall score(s). If a tie remains between two or more boats, they shall be ranked in order of their overall score in the last regatta in which the tied boats competed.

#### 9. RADIO COMMUNICATION

While on the water, the RC may communicate with competing boats via VHF radio, including starting penalties.

#### 10. PRIZES

- 10.1 Trophies will be awarded at CYC after racing on December 8, January 19 and February 9 based on the number of boats entered.
- 10.2 On February 9, a take home trophy will be presented to the Series winner.

#### 11. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in this event at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. By participating in this event, each competitor agrees to release the race organizers (organizing authority, host yacht club, race committee, protest committee, sponsors, and any others acting in an official capacity for this event) from any and all liability associated with such competitor's participation in this event to the fullest extent permitted by law.
