PHRF SOCAL CHAMPIONSHIP MARTIN 242 PACIFIC COAST CHAMPIONSHIP

Amendment #1 to the NOTICE OF RACE 03/31/2021

1. Add to RULES section:

1.5 [DP] IJ70CA Class Rules (CR) Part III, Sections I.4 (Corinthian Division) and I.5 (One-Pro Division) apply.

2. Add to ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY section:

2.3 J/70 class: teams must indicate their eligibility for the Corinthian or One-Pro Division on the registration form in order to be scored as such.

3. Replace DIVISIONS/CLASSES, section 3.6 with:

3.6 Classes with fewer than five (5) entries may have their starts combined, though they will be scored separately. Handicap and onedesign classes in the Performance Division may share the same start.

4. Replace FEES, section 4.1 with:

4.1 The entry fee is \$55 for entries received with the required fees paid by Sunday, May 23. Thereafter, until the entry deadline, the entry fee is \$80. Current members of US Sailing will receive a \$5 discount with proof of membership.

5. Replace section 5 with:

For the J/70, Viper 640, Star, Martin 242, and J/24 classes, seven (7) races are scheduled: four (4) on Saturday and three (3) on Sunday. For all other classes in the Performance Division, five (5) races are scheduled: three (3) on Saturday and two (2) on Sunday. For the Cruising Division, three (3) races are scheduled: two (2) on Saturday and one (1) on Sunday. The RC, at its discretion, may run fewer races for any or all classes.

6. Replace section 10 with:

- 10. LAUNCHING / BERTHING / HAUL-OUT RESTRICTIONS [DP]
- 10.1 Boats in one-design classes specified in the Sailing Instructions will be assigned rafting areas at CYC, and shall remain in the water Saturday night except with, and according to, the terms of prior written permission of the RC. Boat trailers will be stored on CYC grounds in a specified area.
- 10.2 All J/70s must be afloat by 1900 0n Friday, June 4 and shall not be hauled-out until the end of the event except with, and according to, the terms of prior written permission of the RC.

7. Replace section 13 with:

- 13. PRIZES
- 13.1 There will be no awards ceremony at CYC after racing. Arrangements will be made to provide winners with their trophies.
- 13.2 Trophies will be awarded based on the number of entries in each class.
- 13.3 For the J/70 Class, trophies will be awarded to the winners of the Open, One-Pro and the Corinthian Divisions.
- 13.4 In addition, the following trophies will be awarded:
 - The **PHRF SoCal Championship trophies** will be awarded to the winners of the handicap classes at the PHRF SoCal General Meeting in November.
 - The **PHRF SoCal Championship trophies** will be awarded to the winners of the handicap classes at the PHRF SoCal General Meeting in November.
 - The **Junior Crew Trophy** will be awarded to the best scoring boat in each class with at least one junior (<18) aboard. The form for entering the Junior Crew Trophy competition may be found at the <u>Cal Race Week</u> webpage.
 - The M242 Pacific Coast Championship Trophy, which shall remain on display at CYC, will be awarded to the first place Martin 242.
 - The Jimmy Morris Trophy, which shall remain on display at CYC, will be awarded to the first place Schock 35.
 - The **Charles Tanner Trophy**, which shall remain on display at CYC, will be awarded to the first place boat in each handicap class in the Performance Division.
 - The Fred F. Harris Trophy, which shall remain on display at CYC, will be awarded to the first place boat in each one-design class in the Performance Division.
 - The **Thomas K. Armstrong California Challenge Trophy**, which shall remain on display at CYC, will be awarded to the winning yacht club team. The Notice of Challenge may be found at the <u>Cal Race Week</u> webpage
- 8. Replace section 16, Hospitality with:

Hospitality (health guidelines permitting): Competitors and guests are invited to use the club facilities during the event, subject to applicable CYC guidelines and protocols. No postrace social activities will be held at CYC.

A no host breakfast will be available at the club from 0800-1000 on both race days. Entertainment and a complimentary buffet dinner for competitors will be provided after racing on Saturday, with additional dinner tickets available for purchase. Complimentary refreshments will be provided after racing on Sunday.

9. Replace section 16, Boat Launching, Berthing and Storage with:

Boat Launching, Berthing and Storage: Competitors are invited to use the dry storage, hoists and assigned docks at CYC during the event, subject to applicable CYC guidelines and protocols.
