# **GENERAL INFORMATION**

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# 1. RULES

- 1.1 The event is governed by the rules as defined in <u>*The Racing Rules of Sailing*</u> (RRS).
- 1.2 US Sailing Prescription RRS 81 does not apply.

# 2. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The Sailing Instructions (SIs) will be posted by 1800 on Saturday, September 11 on the Official Notice Board.

# 3. COMMUNICATION

- 3.1 The Official Notice Board is the <u>King of the Hill and Cruising Championship</u> webpage. Notices may also be posted on the bulletin board outside the main entrance to the CYC clubhouse.
- 3.2 [DP] All boats shall carry a VHF radio capable of communicating on normal domestic and international channels.
- 3.3 On the water, the Race Committee (RC) may make courtesy broadcasts to competitors on VHF radio, including starting penalties. The channel will be stated in the SIs.
- 3.4 [DP] While racing, except in an emergency, a boat shall not make voice or data transmissions and shall not receive voice or data communication that is not available to all boats.

# 4. CODE OF CONDUCT

- 4.1 [DP] Each race entrant and skipper is responsible for ensuring that all members of their crew, support personnel and their guests abide by the laws, public health orders, and guidance from government authorities and/or CYC applicable to sailing and/or shore side activities in effect during the event to minimize potential exposure to or transmission of the COVID-19 virus.
- 4.2 Reasonable actions by event officials and CYC to implement COVID-19 guidance, protocols or legislation, even if they later prove to have been unnecessary, are not improper actions or omissions.

# 5. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 5.1 Only Sunset Series Cruising Division boats that receive an invitation are eligible to enter, up to a maximum of eight (8) boats.
- 5.2 "Initial Invitations", based on the final standings of the 2021 Sunset Series, will be issued on Wednesday, September 8 to the following:
  - (a) The highest-ranking boats from each Sunset Series class in the Cruising Division determined by average number of starters by class (rounded to the nearest whole number) as follows:

7 or fewer boats	2 invitations
8 or 9 boats	3 invitations
10 or more boats	4 invitations

- (b) The highest-ranking boats from the final overall standings for the 2021 Sunset Series Cruising Division that have not received invitations under NoR 5.2(a) in order to complete the maximum number of eight (8) boats.
- 5.3 "Alternate Invitations" will be issued in the following order:
  - (a) Up to one (1) additional boat by class ranking from each class in the Cruising Division if a boat that is eligible under NoR 5.2(a) does not enter by the deadline specified in NoR 5.6;
  - (b) Additional boats that qualify under 5.2(b) in order to complete the maximum number of eight (8) boats from the Cruising Division;
- 5.4 If there are protests (or appeals) relating to the final standings of the 2021 Sunset Series, the boats entitled to invitations shall be determined by the results as of 2100 on Thursday, September 9.
- 5.5 Eligible boats may enter by completing online registration and paying the required fees at the link on the <u>Official Notice</u> <u>Board</u>.

- 5.6 The entry deadline for boats receiving Initial Invitations is 1800 on Friday, September 10; the entry deadline for boats receiving Alternate Invitations is 1200 on Monday, September 13.
- 5.7 Entries submitted after that time may be accepted at the discretion of the OA.

# 6. CLASSES

All boats will compete in a single class with an "inverted start" format (first boat to finish wins). The starting time for each boat, depending on course distance selected, will be posted by 1200 on Tuesday, September 14 at the <u>Official Notice</u> <u>Board</u> and on the bulletin board outside the main entrance to CYC.

#### 7. FEES

The entry fee is \$17. Current members of US Sailing will receive a \$2 discount with proof of membership.

#### 9. VENUE

The racing area will be on Santa Monica Bay and inside Marina del Rey Harbor.

#### 10. COURSES

Boats will start outside the Harbor at MDR Mark SS (see <u>Marina del Rey Course Chart 17</u>), go to a weather mark, and finish at the CYC Guest Dock.

#### 11. SCORING

This is a pursuit race with individual starting times based on course distance. Boats will be scored according to their order of finish.

#### 12. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors in the event are participating entirely at their own risk. See RRS 3, Decision to Race. By participating in the event, each competitor agrees to release the race organizers (organizing authority, host yacht club, race committee, protest committee, sponsors, and any others acting in an official capacity for the event) from any and all liability associated with such competitor's participation in the event to the fullest extent permitted by law.

#### 13. PRIZES

- 13.1 Health guidelines permitting, the awards ceremony will be held at CYC after racing.
- 13.2 Trophies will be awarded at CYC to the first and second place boats as soon as possible after the race.
- 13.3 The name of the winning boat will be engraved on a perpetual trophy, which shall remain on display at CYC.
