# **GENERAL INFORMATION**

# 1. RULES

- 1.1 The event is governed by the rules as defined in <u>The Racing Rules of Sailing</u> (RRS).
- 1.2 US Sailing Prescription RRS 81 does not apply.

# 2. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

2.1 The Sailing Instructions (SIs) will be posted by Wednesday, August 10 on the Official Notice Board.

# 3. COMMUNICATION

- 3.1 The Official Notice Board is the <u>Summer Regatta</u> webpage. Notices may also be posted on the bulletin board outside the main entrance to the CYC clubhouse.
- 3.2 [DP] All boats shall carry a VHF radio capable of communicating on normal domestic and international channels.
- 3.3 On the water, the Race Committee (RC) may make courtesy broadcasts to competitors on VHF radio, including starting penalties. The channel will be stated in the SIs.
- 3.4 [DP] While racing, except in an emergency, a boat shall not make voice or data transmissions and shall not receive voice or data communication that is not available to all boats.

# 4. CODE OF CONDUCT

- 4.1 [DP] Each race entrant and skipper is responsible for ensuring that all members of their crew, support personnel and their guests abide by the laws, public health orders, and guidance from government authorities and/or CYC applicable to sailing and/or shore side activities in effect during the event to minimize potential exposure to or transmission of the COVID-19 virus.
- 4.2 Failure to comply with NoR 4.1 may be misconduct.
- 4.3 Reasonable actions by event officials and CYC to implement COVID-19 guidance, protocols or legislation, even if they later prove to have been unnecessary, are not improper actions or omissions.

#### 5. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 5.1 This regatta is open to one-design keelboats and to handicap boats that have a valid PHRF SoCal Rating Certificate. Handicap boats must compete in a W/L rated configuration between 0 and 186. Boats outside this range may petition the OA for inclusion.
- 5.2 Eligible boats may enter by completing online registration at the <u>Summer Regatta</u> webpage and paying all fees by the entry deadline of 1800 on Wednesday, August 10. Entries submitted after that time may be accepted only with the approval of the event chairs and will be charged a \$10 late fee.

#### 6. CLASSES

- 6.1 Invited one-design classes are J/70, J/109, and Martin 242. Other one-design classes may petition the event chair for inclusion.
- 6.2 One-design keelboats must have a minimum of three (3) paid entries prior to the entry deadline to establish a class. Those that do not establish a class may compete in a handicap class, if they are in compliance with the handicap boat requirements per NoR 5.1.
- 6.3 Handicap classes will be established at the discretion of the event chair based on entries received by the entry deadline.
- 6.4 Classes with fewer than five (5) entries may have their starts combined, though they will be scored separately.
- 6.5 Classes, class flags, and the order of starts for the first race will be posted on the <u>Official Notice Board</u> by 1200 on Thursday, August 11.

#### 7. FEES

7.1 The entry fee is \$35 for entries received with all fees paid by Wednesday, August 3. Thereafter, until the entry deadline, the entry fee is \$45.

7.2 Current members of US Sailing receive a \$5 discount with proof of membership.

# 8. SCHEDULE

8.1 Four (4) races are scheduled. The RC, at its discretion, may run fewer races.

# 9. VENUE

9.1 The racing area is on Santa Monica Bay with the starting area approximately 1.2 nautical miles northwest of the Marina del Rey breakwater.

# 10. COURSES

Courses are a windward / leeward format.

# 11. SCORING

- 11.1 One (1) race is required to be completed to constitute a series.
- 11.2 A boat's series score is the total of her race scores.
- 11.3 Handicap boats are scored using their valid PHRF SoCal Area B W/L Ratings. Boats from outside of Area B will have Area B adjustments applied as available.

# 12. RISK STATEMENT

Competitors in the event are participating entirely at their own risk. See RRS 3, Decision to Race. By participating in the event, each competitor agrees to release the race organizers (organizing authority, host yacht club, race committee, protest committee, sponsors, and any others acting in an official capacity for the event) from any and all liability associated with such competitor's participation in the event to the fullest extent permitted by law.

# 13. PRIZES

- 13.1 Health guidelines permitting, the awards ceremony will be held at CYC after racing.
- 13.2 Trophies will be awarded based on the number of entries in each class.
